~Caroling~

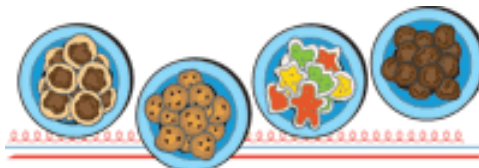
