"I want to thank everyone for their prayers, cards and phone calls while I was awaiting surgery to remove the right adrenal gland and mass from my right kidney. The mass was producing extremely high levels of cortisol, so I am needing to be on high levels of a similar steroid and be weaned down slowly to prevent my body from going into shock. The left adrenal gland is not currently functioning at all and the hope is, as the steroid level drops, it will come out of its coma and start functioning. The main side effect of what the tumor was producing and the steroids I am on is extreme muscle fatigue which makes it difficult to do much of anything. I would ask for continued prayers as I go through this process."

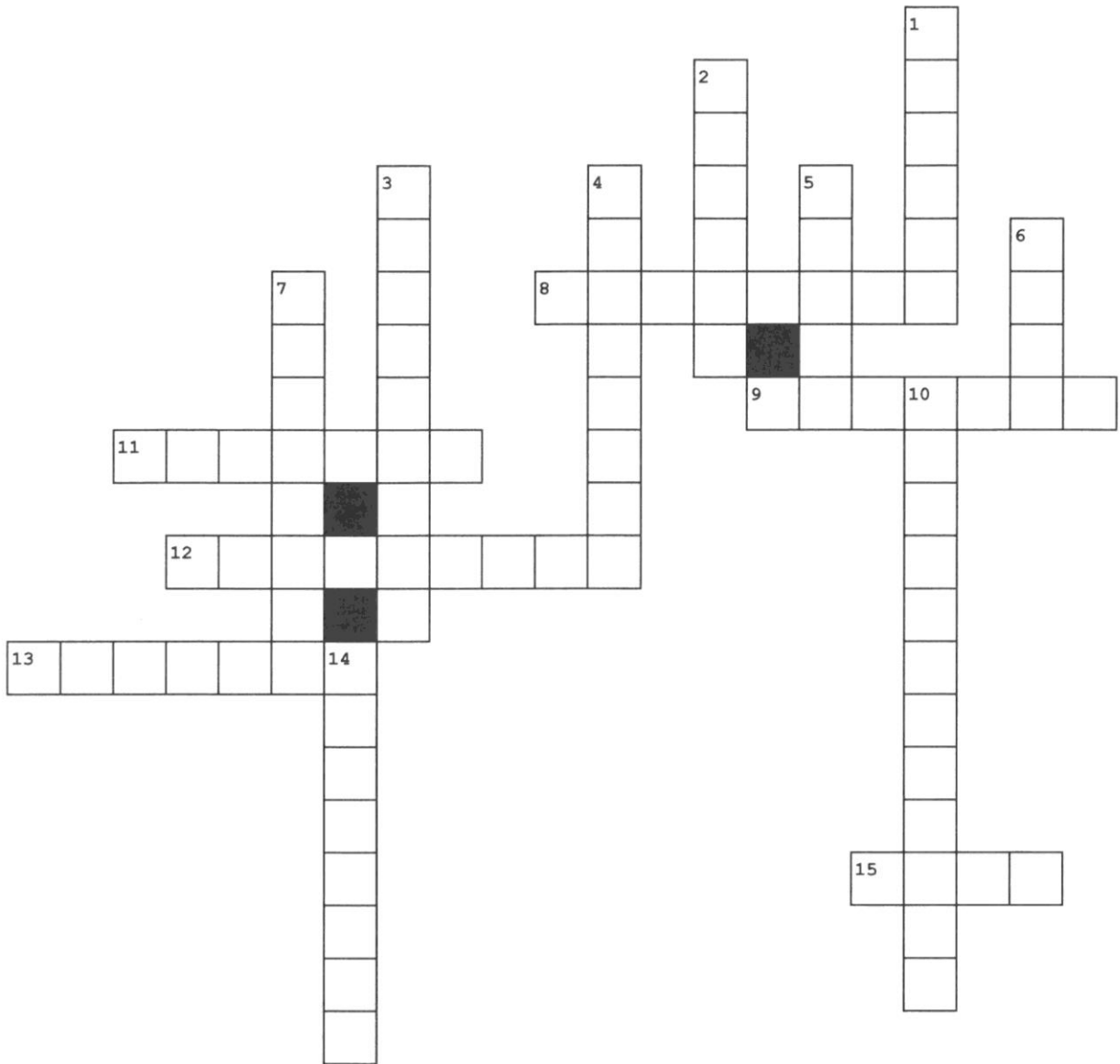
