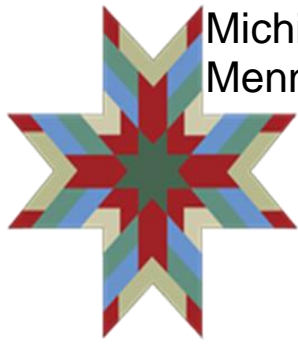

MCC Pipeline to Prison Learning Tour on November 1-3 in Goshen and Elkhart: Join MCC Great Lakes for three days focusing on the complexities of the U.S. criminal justice system as seen in northern Indiana. Participants will learn about the systemic forces at play that have led to mass incarceration and the criminalization of marginalized groups. The group will hear diverse perspectives from community organizations and people experiencing arrest, incarceration and re-entry. Quilt expert Janneken Smucker will give a gallery talk, Saturday, September 16, 2 p.m. in Goshen College's Good Library Gallery. Smucker will speak about quilts featured in the current gallery exhibit: *A Cabinet of Curiosities 3*. A Goshen native, Smucker is professor of history at West Chester University (PA) and authored a definitive book, *Amish Quilts: Crafting an American Icon*. She is also working with forthcoming exhibits and publications for the International Quilt Museum (Nebraska) and the Smithsonian American Art Museum.

Attend a recital featuring Goshen College faculty, Saturday, September 16, 7:30 p.m. in the Goshen College Music Center's Rieth Recital Hall. Goshen College voice professors Scott Hochstetler and H.
