Women's Fellowship wants to thank everyone who made chili for the chili cook off and also thank those individuals that came to eat. We were able to raise \$605 for the daycare.

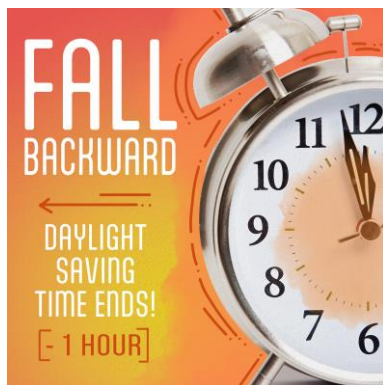
~ Handbell Choir ~
