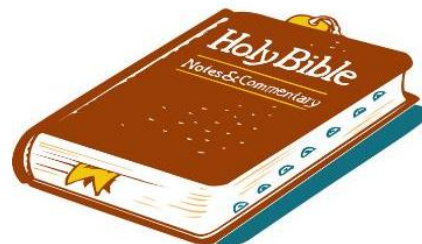
## ~ Church Picnic ~
