They will be joined by the Goshen Community Chorale and perform works from Brahms, Reene Esmail, Lloyd Weber and others. Join MCC to learn about the Dismukes Project and Black history in West Virginia: Tylah Cline and Kristin Overstreet, MCC Appalachia staff, will share the story of Dr. Henry Dodford Dismukes, a Black doctor who started a hospital in the 1930s that faced injustice and was forced to close. After discovering MCC-owned land once held the hospital and nurses' home, MCC began working to tell Dr. Dismukes' story. MCC is in the process of rehabilitating the remaining nurses' home to create a learning center to support the community.
